### Second Circular

## 2. CALL FOR PAPERS NOW OPEN

- To present a paper to one of these panels, anyone interested should submit their proposals using the form on the website:

<https://afit-antropologiafeminista.eus/>

- Each proposal submitted should indicate the panel to which it is applying and, in addition to the abstract, it should include: title, name of the person (s) signing the proposal (up to three authors are permitted), affiliation or institution to which they belong, email address and the language in which the paper will be presented (the accepted languages are specified in each panel).

- The abstract of the proposal should be between 175 and 300 words, as well as 3 to 5 keywords. The font should be Arial, font size 12, and 1.5 line spacing (or equivalents of these). The text should be attached in PDF format as indicated on the online form. The full text of the papers will not be requested, neither at the time of registration nor at a later date.

- Each participant may present only two paper proposals (whether as author or co-author). If more than two proposals signed by the same person are presented, the organization will offer them the chance of choosing which one to

withdraw. If no response is received, we will withdraw the last proposal received.

- Each proposal may be signed by a maximum of three people, but only one of the authors should register the paper on the online form. However, the names of all authors should feature on the text with the summary, to be attached when registering the proposal.

**The call for papers will open on November 5, 2019 and end on January 15, 2020**, both days inclusive.

Once the proposals have been evaluated and accepted, participants must pay the conference registration fee and submit all documents required before March 15, 2020. Failure to do so will signify removal of their paper from the programme.

Please pay particular attention to the writing, style, spelling, technical vocabulary and content in the abstracts submitted, and follow the guidelines regarding the minimum and maximum number of words in your summary, since that will be the information the Scientific Committee will take into account when evaluating the proposals, and what is published in the Conference Program and printed on certificates.
